RE: **City Council Bill 14-0323 – Baltimore City Landmark List: Public Interiors – St. John’s in the Village**

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 14-0323, for the purpose of designating St. John’s in the Village, 3009½ Greenmount Avenue, as a historical landmark: public interior.
