20	The rules and regulations that the Commissioner adopts under § 2-106 of this article may
21	include provisions:

17 18	(I) ANY NATIVE OR FOREIGN WILDLIFE WHOSE POSSESSION OR SALE IS PROHIBITED BY FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL LAW; AND
19 20	(II) ANY OTHER ANIMAL THAT THE COMMISSIONER SO SPECIFIES BY RULE OR REGULATION.
21	(3) FARM ANIMAL.
22	"FARM ANIMAL" MEANS ANY:
23	(I) BOVINE;
24	(II) EQUINE;
25	(III) PORCINE;
26	(IV) CAPRINE; OR
27	(V) DOMESTIC FOWL.
