10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
11 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

13 **Article 31. Transit and Traffic**

14 **Subtitle 10. Residential Permit Parking Program**

15 **§ 10-38. Guilford Area.**

16 (a) *Area delineated.*

17 The Guilford Area consists of:

18 (1) the unit blocks of St. Martin’s Road and East Bishops Road; and

19 (2) **3701, 3703**, 3705, and 3801 N. Charles Street.

20 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
21 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
22 Ordinance.
