FOR the purpose of modifying the effective date of Ordinance 19-308 {“Whistleblower Rights and Responsibilities”}; and providing for a special effective date.

Section 3

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:
