6 FOR the purpose of transferring a Bond Fund Capital Appropriation in the amount of \$1,500,000
7 from the Baltimore City Public Schools (Account #9904-129-086) to the Department of
8 Housing and Community Development (Account #9910-587-037); and providing for a
9 special effective date.

15 **Recitals**

16 Article VI, § 9(a)(2) of the City Charter provides that, on recommendation of the Board of
17 Estimates, the City Council by ordinance may authorize the transfer of an appropriation
18 contained in the Ordinance of Estimates from one municipal agency to another municipal
19 agency.

20 On September 26, 2007, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
21 Council.

22 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
23 sum of \$1,500,000, contained in the Fiscal 2006 Ordinance of Estimates as a Bond Fund Capital
24 Appropriation, is transferred from the Baltimore City Public Schools (Account #9904-129-086)
25 to the Department of Housing and Community Development (Account #9910-587-037).

26 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it
27 is enacted.
