I am herein reporting on City Council Bill #11-0754.

The purpose of the bill is to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain parcels of land known as the former beds of certain streets and alleys in the area bounded by Ensor Street, Monument Street, Aisquith Street, and Oldtown Mall and lying within the Oldtown Urban Renewal Project and no longer needed for public use; and provide for a special effective date.

This bill would enable consolidation of several properties in preparation for redevelopment of the Oldtown Mall into a mixed-use commercial center. The new development would include a grocery store, mixed-income residential units and landscaping, with improved connectivity to the surrounding communities. The Department of Transportation has no objections to the passage of this bill.
