1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation –**
3 **Department of Public Works – \$1,500,000**

4 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the
5 amount of \$1,500,000 to the Department of Public Works – Service 663 (Waste Removal and
6 Recycling), to provide funding for additional operating expenses; and providing for a special
7 effective date.

13 **Recitals**

14 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from Income Tax in excess of
15 the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance
16 the budget for Fiscal Year 2019.

17 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
18 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2019 was formulated.

19 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
20 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2019 was formulated or is for a new program that could
21 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.

22 On May 8, 2019, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City Council.

1 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
2 \$1,500,000 shall be made available to the Department of Public Works – Service 663 (Waste
3 Removal and Recycling) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal
4 Year 2019, to provide funding for additional operating expenses. The source of revenue for this
5 appropriation is funds from Income Tax in excess of the amount from this source that was relied
6 on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal
7 Year 2019.

8 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
9 enacted.
