The proposed legislation would provide for the purpose of granting a franchise to Exxon-Mobil to construct, use and maintain a private product recovery system pipeline under and across a portion of the Boston Street right-of-way, connecting facilities located on the properties known as 4200 Boston Street and 1610 South Newkirk Street, subject to certain terms, conditions, and reservations; and providing for a special effective date.

The Fire Department does not object to City Council Bill # 08-0114 provided that all applicable sections of the Fire and Building Codes are adhered. This may include a requirement for plans to be submitted to the Fire Department, an annual Fire Inspection, permit, automatic sprinkler system, and Fire Alarm system, and all City and Maryland State requirements for a recovery system are met.
