1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **City Streets – Naming an Unnamed Alley Jazz Alley**

3 FOR the purpose of naming an unnamed alley, located perpendicular to and between South  
4 Carrollton Avenue and South Carlton Street, parallel with West Baltimore Street and Hollins  
5 Street.

11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That an  
12 unnamed 10-foot alley located perpendicular to and between South Carrollton Avenue and South  
13 Carlton Street, being parallel with West Baltimore Street and Hollins Street, is named Jazz  
14 Alley.

15 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
16 after the date it is enacted.
