9 10	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE , That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

12	Article 2. Consumer Protections
13	Subtitle 10. Motor Fuel Sales
14	§ 10-3. Motor fuel service station facilities.
15	(a) In general.
16	The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore finds and declares that the public health,
17	safety, welfare, and convenience require motor fuel service stations offering motor fuel
18	for sale at retail to the public, have and maintain toilet and hand washing facilities[, air
19	pumps for tire inflation,] and water for motor vehicle purposes.
20	(c) Free services required.
21	After January 1, 1980, every retail dealer licensed under this subtitle who opens a new
22	motor fuel service station shall provide free of charge to patrons the following:

6	(3) [(4)] at least 1 water outlet in good operating condition and accessible to patrons.
7 8 9	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.
