Re: **City Council Bill 17-0133 - City Streets - Closing - Water Street and Hollingsworth Street**

---

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 17-0133, for the purpose of condemning and closing Water Street, extending from Grant Street easterly 157.35 feet, more or less, to South Calvert Street, and condemning and opening Hollingsworth Street, extending from Water Street southerly 159.6 feet, more or less, to East Lombard Street, as shown on Plat 234-A-37 in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

If enacted, this bill, a companion bill to CC 17-0134 (City Streets – Opening – Water Street and Hollingsworth Street), would close portions of Water and Hollingsworth Streets that are no longer needed in the City.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the passage of City Council Bill 17-0133.
