SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That Sheet 69 of the Zoning District Maps is amended by changing from the M-3 Zoning District to the R-8 Zoning District the properties known as 820 Oldham Street, 4526 O'Donnell Street, 4600 O'Donnell Street, and a portion of 4500 Fait Avenue, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, and that Sheet 59 of the Zoning District Maps is amended by changing from the M-1-2 Zoning District to the R-8 Zoning District the properties known as 4601 Foster Avenue, a portion of 4500 Fait Avenue, and 4700 Fait Avenue, as outlined in blue on the plat accompanying this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council
