Dear Morgan Community:

I am writing to inform you that the Morgan State University Board of Regents, in a specially

called meeting held last evening, approved the Memorandum of Agreement the University had negotiated with the AFSCME union that represents our non-exempt employees. The University has been in negotiations with the Union for nearly ten months on a new three year agreement and I'm pleased we were able to reach a deal, which will carry us through June 30, 2020.

I thank all members of our bargaining team for the long hours they devoted to this process. Morgan values all of its employees, and in these negotiations, our goal was, and will always be, to ensure that our staff know how much they are valued by our providing them with competitive wages and benefits that are within the financial constraints of the University.

As many of you know, Morgan has, for decades, employed a large number of "contractual" workers. This means that these colleagues of ours enjoyed few fringe benefits, beyond their salary. This situation is a byproduct of the State of Maryland's not investing over the decades in Morgan in the way it invested in its other universities. This has been a major concern of mine since I assumed the presidency.

Effective July 1, 2018, we will cease the practice of the wholesale hiring of "contractual" staff. That means that we will no longer hire individuals if we don't

have the resources to provide them benefits, and we will have to staff accordingly. Meanwhile, we will start a conversion process this year to convert certain numbers of staff, as per our Agreement with the Union, and as many additional staff as State resources can accommodate.

I thank the Board of Regents for convening in special session last night to take action on the AFSCME MOU. It shows their commitment to fair labor practices at our University.

Background

If enacted, Bill 17-0142 would grant to the State of Maryland Transit Administration three (3) perpetual easements for supporting slopes through property owned by the City. This proposed construction would protect the Maryland Transit Administration's Light Rail track by providing a gabion (wired caged) retaining wall with riprap (stone foundation) toe armoring on the bank of the Jones Falls waterway.

This site is located in the 6^{th} Council District: South of W. Cold Spring Lane – North of W. 41^{st} Street – and along the West border of I – 83 South. Over the course of this project, approximately 425 feet of existing gabion mattresses and baskets will be repaired, and approximately 700 feet of eroded stream bank will be cleared for installation of the new gabion wall. This project has been estimated at between 1 million and 2.5 million dollars. It has been federally funded and federal minimum wage rates do apply.

The property, was once part of The Arundel Corporation which by deed dated January 3, 1979 and recorded among the Land Record of Baltimore City in Liber 3714 Folio 870 was conveyed to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore. The property is not park property, nor a right of way, and is not accessible or used for other public purposes.
