FOR the purpose of changing the name of School #425, located at 2801 Saint Lo Drive, to Heritage High School.

Baltimore City Code  
(Edition 2000)

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the name of School #425, located at 2801 Saint Lo Drive, is changed to Heritage High School.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
