Re: **City Council Bill 10-0508 - City Streets - Closing - Ivymount Road**

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 10-0508, which was introduced for the purpose of condemning and closing Ivymount Road, extending from the westernmost extremity thereof, Easterly 90.0 feet, more or less, as shown on Plat 349-A-25A in the Office of the Department of General Services.

The intended purchaser, Mr. Howard Friedman, owns the property known as 6201 Green Meadow Way. The public street known as Ivymount Road borders the rear property boundary of Mr. Friedman's property and terminates at a green area and stream. Mr. Friedman would like to close the portion of Ivymount Road that abuts his property, purchase it and incorporate it into his property. He hopes to eliminate a problem with trash being dumped in this area.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the adoption of City Council Bill 10-0508.
