Re: City Council Bill 09-0300 Sale of Property - The Former Bed of

Hunter Street

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 09-0300, which was introduced for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in a certain parcel of land known as the former bed of Hunter Street, extending from the north side of a 10-foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties known as 210 through 218/220-222 East Preston Street Northerly 94.1 feet, more or less, to the south side of a 7-foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties known as 209 through 217 East Mount Royal Avenue and no longer needed for public use.

The sale of this street bed will facilitate the owner of the adjoining apartment buildings, Osprey-Bolton Square Printers, LLC, to create a courtyard between both buildings. The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the adoption of City Council Bill 09-0300.
