I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 11-0758 introduced by Council members Kraft and D'Adamo.

The purpose of the Bill is to amend the Urban Renewal Plan for Canton Industrial Area to add a new land use category to the permitted land uses in the plan and to revise Exhibits 1 and 4 to reflect the change in zoning upon approval by separate ordinance for block 6505, lots 1/9, 9A and 10; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

The Urban Renewal Plan for Canton Industrial Area was originally approved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore by Ordinance 90-528 and last amended by Ordinance 07-390.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority reviewed the amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for Canton Industrial Area and determined it would have no negative impact to parking in that area. The Parking Authority would make our staff readily available to other City agencies and/or work-groups on any parking activity within the area of this Urban Renewal Plan.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority supports the passage of City Council Bill 11-0758.
