FOR the purpose of designating Dr. John Ruhrah Elementary Middle School (School #228), 701 Rappolla Street, as a historical landmark: exterior.

BY adding

Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

DR. JOHN RUHRAH ELEMENTARY MIDDLE SCHOOL (SCHOOL #228), 701 RAPPOLLA STREET.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
