Re: **City Council Bill 12-0131 – Baltimore City Landmark List – St. Alphonsus Hall**

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 12-0131, which was introduced for the purpose of designating St. Alphonsus Hall, 125 West Saratoga Street, as a historical landmark.
