Re: City Council Bill 14-0342 – Bond Issue – Recreation, Parks and Public
Facilities Loan - \$47,000,000

Dear Madame President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 14-0342 (Bond Issue – Recreation and Parks and Public Facilities Loan - \$47,000,000) for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would authorize the Mayor and City Council to create a debt not exceeding \$47,000,000 (the “Debt”) for purposes of improving the City’s park and recreational land, property, buildings and facilities, providing for tree planning programs and for the purposes of improving and development of buildings owned or controlled by the Mayor and City Council and the Enoch Pratt Free Library, which may include acquisition of property, construction of new buildings or other facilities, and renovation or repair of existing buildings or facilities.

The intent of the Bill is to ensure that the Debt is created as a general obligation of the City, pursuant to Section 7 of Article XI of the Constitution of Maryland. The Bill also contains provisions concerning the use of the funds, the issuance of the bonds, and other matters. After approval by the Mayor and City Council, the ordinance will be presented to the voters for approval on November 4, 2014.

The Law Department approves Council Bill 14-0342 for form and legal sufficiency.
