I am herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 09-0363.

Sale of Property – The Former Beds of Certain Streets Lying Within the Uplands Apartment Complex and Bounded by Edmondson Avenue, Athol Avenue, Pen Lucy Road and Uplands Parkway

For the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain parcels of land known as the former beds of certain streets lying within the Pen-Lucy Road and Uplands Parkway and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

The Department of Transportation has reviewed CCB 09-0363. The streets to be sold lie within the footprint of the Uplands Master Plan. The developer will consolidate the street beds with other lots. New streets will be developed to serve the community's ingress and egress needs.

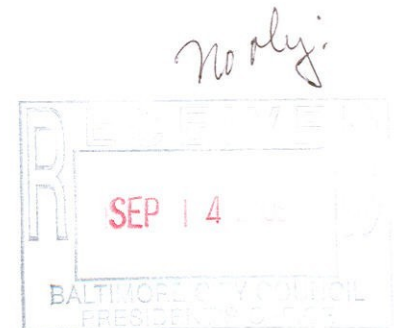
The Department of Transportation has no objections to the passage of this bill.
