City Streets – Closing – A Portion of South Eden Street and a Portion of
Alicecanna Street

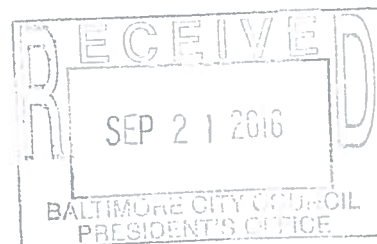
The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) has been asked to comment on City Council Bill No. 16-0745 for the purpose of condemning and closing a portion of South Eden Street, extending from Lancaster Street northerly 308 feet, more or less, to Alicecanna Street, and a portion of South Eden Street, as shown on Plat 235-A-42A in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

The street opening will allow for the development of a 22-story mixed-use project consisting of 282 apartments, 35 condominiums, structured parking, and a ground floor retail space that will include a 55,000 square foot Whole Foods Market.

BDC supports Bill No. 16-0745 and respectfully requests that favorable consideration is given by the City Council.
