12	SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
13	City Charter is proposed to be amended to read as follows:

17	(a) Authorization.
18	By Ordinance, the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore may establish 1 or
19	MORE CONTINUING, NONLAPSING FUNDS FOR PURPOSES OF PROMOTING SUSTAINABILITY
20	and a clean and safe environment within the City of Baltimore, including:
21	(1) ADMINISTERING THE ACTIVITIES OF A CITY OFFICE OF SUSTAINABILITY;
22	(2) PERFORMING EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH ON SUSTAINABILITY ISSUES;

14	(3) THEIR APPROPRIATIONS DO NOT LAPSE.
15 16	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED , That this proposed amendment to the City Charter be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of Baltimore City, for adoption or
17	rejection, in accordance with Article XI-A, § 5 of the Maryland Constitution, in the form
18	specified by the City Solicitor.
