14	Avenue, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with			
15	Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 4-1004(4) and 14-102, subject to the condition that the following			
16	conditions:			
17	1. The site plan, dated November 1, 2013, is attached to and made part of this			
18	Ordinance.			
19	2. On the termination of this Ordinance, the owner of 4001 Roland Avenue must, as			
20	nearly as possible, restore the parking area to its original condition, including grass			
21	seeding, as necessary.
