> City Council Bill 08-0022 - Urban Renewal - Hamilton Business Area -Re: Amendment

Dear Madame President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 08-0022 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill as introduced specifies prohibited uses - including religious institutions in the Community Business Area and provides that an existing use that does not comply with this Renewal Plan would be allowed to continue for an indefinite period of time. The Planning Commission recommended amendments to the bill that remove the prohibition against religious institutions and provide that a lawfully existing use that does not conform to the applicable use regulations of the Renewal Plan may be continued as a "nonconforming use" pursuant to Title 13 of the Zoning Code. The Law Department supports the amendments recommended by the Planning Commission.

City Council Bill 08-0022 is in accordance with the Housing and Urban Renewal Article of the Baltimore City Code. See Baltimore City Code, Article 13, § 2-6. Therefore, subject to the amendments recommended by the Planning Commission, the Law Department approves the bill for form and legal sufficiency.
