I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 10-0633 introduced by Councilmen Henry and Curran .

The purpose of the Bill is to amend the Urban Renewal Plan for the York-Woodbourne Business Area to reauthorize the acquisition of properties within the Project Area; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date,.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, and has determined that there will no impact to parking in that area with the amendment of this Urban Renewal Plan. The Parking Authority would make our staff readily available to other City agencies and or work-groups on any parking activity within this Urban Renewal Plan area.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc., supports the passage of City Council Bill 10-0633.
