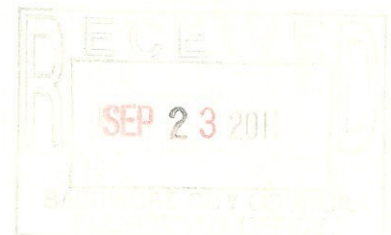

RE: City Council Bill 11-0698-Residential Permit Parking-Pimlico Race Track

The Baltimore Police Department (BPD) has reviewed City Council Bill 11-0698-Residential Permit Parking-Pimlico Race Track. The bill proposes to modify the boundaries of the residential permit parking for the Pimlico Race Track Area.

The BPD has only enforcement responsibilities in this area and shares these responsibilities with the Parking Authority of Baltimore City. It is recognized that there are limited parking options within certain neighborhoods and that modifying the boundaries for residential parking permits would allow residents additional parking within their communities.
