3 FOR the purpose of amending the maximum bed capacity for the home for homeless persons on
4 the property known as 1017 East Baltimore Street, as outlined in red on the accompanying
5 plat.

9 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
10 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
13 BALTIMORE, That permission is granted for the establishment,
14 maintenance, and operation of a home for homeless persons on the
15 property known as 1017 East Baltimore Street, as outlined in red on the
16 plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Zoning Code §§ 6-
17 409(1) and 14-102 of the Baltimore City Code, subject to the following
18 conditions:

19 1. The maximum number of beds is [50] 100, all of which
20 must be used for the housing of homeless men who
21 have successfully completed the Mission’s Spiritual
22 Recovery Program.
