At its regular meeting of January 13, 2015, the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation considered City Council Bill #14-0453, for the purpose of placing on the Landmark List the Olmsted Parkways also known as the public right-of-ways of the 2600-3200 blocks of The Alameda, 0000-1800 blocks of 33rd Street, and 1600-3900 blocks of the Gwynns Falls Parkway. This designation includes the medians, roadways, and sidewalks.

In its consideration of this bill, the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation reviewed the attached staff report which recommended approval with an amendment of City Council Bill #14-0453 and adopted the following resolution, nine members being present (nine in favor).

RESOLVED, That the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation accepted staff recommendation that City Council Bill #14-0453 be amended and passed by the City Council.

The amendment is as follows:

- 1) Because this landmark only consists of the public right-of-way, any proposed work is exempt from obtaining a building permit (Art. 6 section 4-1 of CHAP ordinance).
- 2) Because this landmark is a public right-of-way, CHAP must accommodate any traffic safety and engineering concerns when reviewing proposed changes to this landmark.
