I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 14-0454, Urban Renewal - Inner Harbor Project I - Amendment \_\_\_, for the purpose of amending the Urban Renewal Plan for Inner Harbor Project I to delete a building requirement for a certain development area, to delete in its entirety a certain development area from the Plan, and to amend certain exhibits to the Plan to reflect the deletion of that development area; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

This bill includes a number of amendments to the Inner Harbor Project I Urban Renewal Plan, mostly which remove prohibitions against developing at-grade and above-grade parking structures. DOT has no objections to this bill. Thank you for this opportunity to comment.

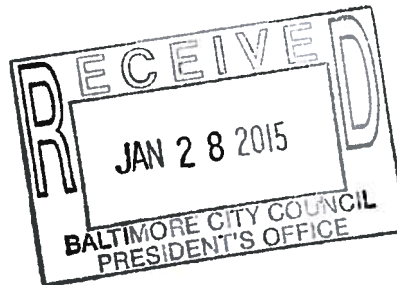
