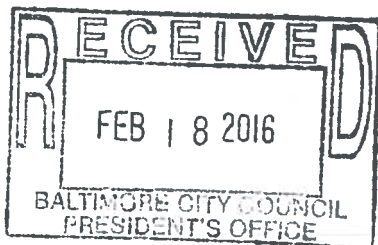

City Council Bill #15-0263R has been introduced for the purpose of supporting efforts to improve access to broadband internet service in Baltimore, and calls for the development of City policies to advance these efforts as well as a comprehensive broadband development and implementation plan for Baltimore City.
