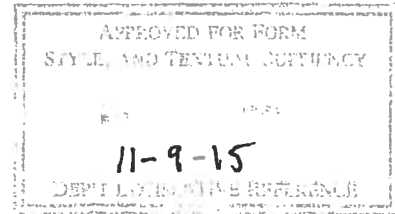


AMENDMENTS TO COUNCIL BILL 15-0204R

Amendment No. 1

On page 1, in line 7, and on page 2, in line 22, in each instance, after “Commission,” insert “the mission of which would be to increase communication and collaboration among representatives of the City’s African American attractions, heritage and tourism community, in order to support individual businesses and sites as well as to assist ongoing city-wide efforts to promote and preserve Baltimore’s rich African American history and cultural assets;”.

Amendment No. 2

On page 1, in line 8, and on page 2, in line 23, in each instance, after “Commission”, insert “the funds of which should be new funds and in no way should be drawn from or impact the budgets of those agencies that are already working in the areas of tourism promotion and heritage preservation, including, but not limited to, Visit Baltimore, the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation, and the Baltimore Heritage Area Association, agencies with whom the Commission would collaborate and not compete”.

Amendment No. 3

On page 1, in line 25, after the period, insert “The Commission would provide a formal body under which representatives from Baltimore’s tourism, entertainment, business, and heritage preservation communities could work together to research, identify, catalog, and link the history of Baltimore’s African American community and could share those findings with interested persons and organizations, including prospective funders, etc. The Commission would also serve as an added resource and unified voice in liaising with the tourism and historic preservation agencies of the City and the State of Maryland.”; and on the same page, strike lines 26 through 30 in their entireties.

Amendment No. 4

On page 2, in line 3, strike beginning with “including” down through “etc”, in line 6.
