1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Rezoning – Block 7027D, Lots 9-12**
3 **(100 Block of Riverside Road)**

4 FOR the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as Block 7027D, Lots 9-12 (100
5 block of Riverside Road), as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the M-2-1
6 Zoning District to the R-6 Zoning District.

13 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That
14 Sheet 96 of the Zoning District Maps is amended by changing from the M-2-1 Zoning District to
15 the R-6 Zoning District the property known as Block 7027D, Lots 9-12 (100 block of Riverside
16 Road), as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance.

17 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That as evidence of the authenticity of the
18 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning
19 Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council
20 shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;
21 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the
22 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of
23 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and
24 the Zoning Administrator.

25 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
26 after the date it is enacted.
