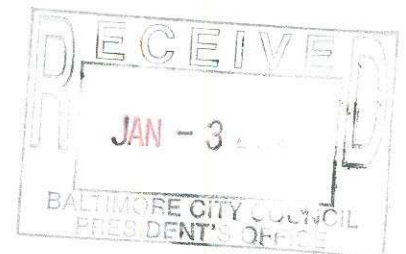
The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 13-0287 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would change the termination date for the Historic Rehabilitation and Restoration Tax Credit program to allow applications for the tax credit to be received until February 29, 2016.

The General Assembly has given the City the authority to enact this tax credit. Md. Code, Tax-Prop., §9-204.1. The extension of this program is consistent with this state enabling legislation. The Law Department approves this bill for form and legal sufficiency.
