AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

Annual Property Tax – Fiscal Year 2026

FOR the purpose of providing a tax for the use of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for
 the period of July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026; and setting the semiannual payment service
 charge for that period.

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That for 6 the period of July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026, a tax is levied and imposed for the use of the 7 Mayor and City Council of Baltimore on all property in the City of Baltimore (except property

8 exempt by law), as follows:

- 9 (a) except as otherwise specified in item (b) of this section, a tax of \$2.248 is levied and
 10 imposed on every \$100 of assessed or assessable value of real property; and
- 11 (b) a tax of \$5.62 is levied and imposed on every \$100 of assessed or assessable value of:
- 12 (1) personal property; and
- 13 (2) operating real property described in State Tax-Property Article § 8-109(c).

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this tax shall be paid and collected in the manner prescribed by law including the provisions of Section 10-210 of the Tax-Property Article of the Annotated Code of the Public General Laws of Maryland.

- 17 **SECTION 3.** AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That for the period July 1, 2025, through
- June 30, 2026, the semiannual payment service charge to be imposed under State Tax-Property
- 19 Article § 10-204.3 is 0.9625%.
- 20 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is 21 enacted.
