



**Council Bill 07-0574**

1 At the time he was appointed Police Commissioner, he recalled that he always  
2 tried to keep to four guiding principles in his life: prudence, integrity, morality,  
3 and God. And referring to a subject that became an issue years before his  
4 appointment, he said that it was those principles, coupled with his experience and  
5 education, that brought him to the command of the police force — not color. He  
6 also said that Baltimore was “one city, one people” and that he would serve as  
7 Police Commissioner “to all the people”. And his actions as Police  
8 Commissioner show that he did just that. Baltimore and the State of Maryland are  
9 better places today because of Bishop L. Robinson’s contributions of service.

10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
11 Baltimore City Police Department Headquarters, located at 601 East Fayette Street, is named the  
12 Bishop L. Robinson, Sr. Headquarters Police Administration Building.

13 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on ~~the 30<sup>th</sup> day~~
