I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 08-0216 introduced by Council President Rawlings Blake on behalf of the Administration (Baltimore Development Corporation).

The purpose of the Bill is to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain property known as 516 East 25<sup>th</sup> Street (Block 4062, Lot 31A) and no longer needed for public use.

The subject property is located on the north side of East 25<sup>th</sup> Street, between Greenmount Avenue and Loch Raven Road. The property measures approximately 31.5 feet by 110 feet by 25 feet by 153 feet and is improved with a one story attached brick building. Having checked our records, this Department has no utility or other interests that would be affected by the proposed sale.

Based on these findings, the Department of Public Works has no objection to the passage of City Council Bill 08-0216.
