**INTRODUCTION** – Sale of Property - 3200 East Biddle Street

**PURPOSE/PLANS** – For the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain property known as 3200 East Biddle Street (Ward 26, Section 20, Block 6150A, Lot 004) and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

**COMMENTS** – This bill looks to authorize the sale of 3200 East Biddle Street, a property that is currently owned by the City of Baltimore. The land was purchased by Baltimore City years ago for the purposes of environmental remediation of the property. Prior to being purchased by Baltimore City, a paint factory operated on the parcel. The prospective property buyer intends to primarily use the property for vehicle and equipment storage.

**AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION** – The Department of Transportation currently foresees no direct fiscal nor operational impact resulting from the advancement of Council Bill 20-0537. The Department of Transportation has **no objection** to City Council bill 20-0537.
