2	(b) Food.
3	(1) In general.
4 5 6	"Food" means any natural or artificial substance or ingredient, whether raw, cooked or processed, that is used or sold or intended for use or sale, in whole or in part, for human consumption.
7	(2) Inclusions.
8	"Food" includes:
9	(i) ice;
10	(ii) beverages; and
11	(iii) chewing gum or any substance used as a component of chewing gum.
12	(3) Exclusions.
13	"Food" does not include any:
14	(i) alcoholic beverage, as defined in State Code Article 2B, § 1-102(a)(2); or
15	(ii) drug, as defined in § 21-101(g) of the State Health-General Article.
16	(c) Food service facility.
17	(1) In general.
18	"Food service facility" means any place in which, with or without charge:
19	(i) food is prepared for sale or service on the premises or elsewhere; or
20 21	(ii) food is manufactured, processed, stored, packaged, handled, distributed, or sold.
22	(2) Exclusions.
23 24	"Food service facility" does not include any private residence in which food is prepared for consumption, without charge, by residents and their guests.

27	(A) "FOOD CONTAINING TRANS FAT" DEFINED.

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1 2	(1) "FOOD CONTAINING TRANS FAT" MEANS, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, ANY FOOD THAT:		
3 4	(I) IS LABELED AS CONTAINING VEGETABLE SHORTENING, MARGARINE, OR ANY KIND OF PARTIALLY HYDROGENATED VEGETABLE OIL;		
5	(II) LISTS VEGETABLE SHORTENING, MARGARINE, OR ANY KIND OF PARTIALLY		
6	HYDROGENATED VEGETABLE OIL AS AN INGREDIENT; OR		
7	(III) CONTAINS VEGETABLE SHORTENING, MARGARINE, OR ANY KIND OF PARTIALLY		
8	HYDROGENATED VEGETABLE OIL.		
9	(2) "FOOD CONTAINING TRANS FAT" DOES NOT INCLUDE FOOD WITH A NUTRITION FACTS		
10 11	Label or other documentation from the manufacturer that lists the food's trans fat content as less than $0.5\mathrm{Grams}$ per serving.

3	(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, food containing		
4	TRANS FAT MAY NOT BE STORED, DISTRIBUTED, HELD FOR SERVICE, USED IN		
15	PREPARATION OF ANY MENU ITEM, OR SERVED IN ANY FOOD SERVICE FACILITY.		
6	(2) This subsection does not apply to food that is served directly to patrons in

9	(1) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, A FOOD SERVICE		
20	FACILITY MUST MAINTAIN ON SITE THE ORIGINAL LABEL FOR ANY FOOD:		
21	(A) THAT CONTAINS FATS, OILS, OR SHORTENINGS;		
22	(B) THAT IS REQUIRED BY FEDERAL OR STATE LAW TO HAVE A LABEL WHEN		
23	PURCHASED BY A FOOD SERVICE FACILITY; AND		
24	(C) THAT IS STORED, DISTRIBUTED, HELD FOR SERVICE, USED IN PREPARATION		
25	OF ANY MENU ITEMS, OR SERVED BY THE FOOD SERVICE FACILITY.		
26	(II) THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER MAY PERMIT A FOOD SERVICE FACILITY TO SUBMIT		
27	ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTATION FROM THE MANUFACTURER THAT INDICATES		
28	WHETHER A FOOD CONTAINS VEGETABLE SHORTENING, MARGARINE, OR ANY KIND		
29	OF PARTIALLY HYDROGENATED VEGETABLE OIL, OR THAT INDICATES A FOOD'S

31	(3) If a food contains fats, oils, or shortenings and is not required to be		
32	LABELED WHEN PURCHASED, THE FOOD SERVICE FACILITY MUST OBTAIN AND		
33	MAINTAIN DOCUMENTATION FROM THE MANUFACTURER THAT INDICATE WHETHER		
34	THE FOOD CONTAINS VEGETABLE SHORTENING, MARGARINE, OR ANY KIND OF		
35	PARTIALLY HYDROGENATED VEGETABLE OIL, OR THAT INDICATES THE FOOD'S TRANS		
36	FAT CONTENT.
