My name is Yeshiyah B. Israel, residence of 1629 Carswell, Mr. Allen Scott is my brother. As in the email below, these questions have not been answered since October 27, 2021. I am in the process of purchasing this property however know bank lends to a building is this condition. I know Mayor Scott encourages folks as myself a Guardian, alumni community planner to help improve communities. However I need your help, support and encouragement for me to continue this effort of improving my surrounding where I dwell.

Please read below.

A few years back CHM, along with the resident of the adjacent unit, discussed with then Commissioner Braverman the need for emergency demolition of 1631 Carswell Street. Since then, the condition of this structurally compromised property has worsened and poses an even greater threat to the neighboring unit and public safety.

The high winds have dislodged even more bricks from the structure and even I am afraid to go in for a closer look. The SR# is 831022.

Please expedite the demolition of this property. I fear for the safety of residents in that area.
