

Please be advised of the following comments offered on behalf of the Baltimore Commission on Sustainability. The CoS discussed the Informational Hearing on Police and Cyclists resolution at the December 22nd 2009 meeting.

The intent of this resolution addresses the following goals of the Baltimore Sustainability Plan as approved by City Council on March 2, 2009:

- Pollution Prevention Goal #1: Reduce Baltimore’s greenhouse gas emissions by 15% by 2015;
- Resource Conservation Goal #1: Reduce Baltimore’s energy use by 15% by 2015;
- Transportation Goal #2: Make Baltimore bicycle and pedestrian friendly; and
- Education & Awareness Goal #3: Raise the environmental awareness of the Baltimore community.

It was the consensus of the CoS to support City Council Bill #09-0175R at the December 22, 2009 meeting.
