Council Bill No. 19-0475 – Zoning – Conditional Use Conversion of a Single-Family

Dwelling Unit to 2 Dwelling Units in the R-8 Zoning District – 806 Reservoir Street

INTRODUCTION

The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) is reporting on City Council Bill 19-0475 introduced by Councilmember Pinkett at the request of Whitestone Holdings Properties, LLC.

PURPOSE

For the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the conversion of a single-family dwelling unit to 2 dwelling units in the R-8 Zoning District on the property known as 806 Reservoir Street.

BRIEF HISTORY

The property was built in 1900 and is located in the Reservoir Hill neighborhood of West Baltimore. The owner seeks to convert the property into two dwelling units to maximize the income potential of the property and offer additional housing options in the neighborhood beyond what a single-family dwelling would allow.
