SUBJECT: Council Bill 24-601 – Property Taxes – Special Rate for Vacant and Abandoned

Property

INTRODUCTION

The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) is reporting on City Council Bill 24-601 introduced by Council President Mosby.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to authorize a special increased property tax rate to be assessed for vacant and abandoned properties. The special tax rate will only be assessed on vacant or abandoned properties with structures in place, and will not extend to vacant lots.

BRIEF HISTORY

This special tax rate is not intended as a means to generate additional revenue for the City. The goal is to encourage redevelopment and reduce blight by accelerating the pace at which a vacant or abandoned property accumulates unpaid tax liens, eventually triggering the in rem foreclosure process which will allow the property to go to tax sale.
