Major Issues Discussed

- Vice Chair Middleton called the Hearing to Order, introducing the members and the bill
- The floor was open to a presentation from Councilmember Dorsey (slides in file)
- Questions for sponsor
 - What is the difference for evacuation in a single v double staircase

- With modern materials and systems, most fires don't actually spread more time for people to get out and limits the possibility of a conflict between people evacuating and BCFD responding
- O What is a pressurized stairwell?
 - Technology is usually seen in high-rise buildings to keep them clear of smoke and usable in an evacuation. These would be incorporated in smaller units under the bill.
- o How will this affect residents aging in place?
 - These buildings can still have elevators not a requirement
 - Will be guided by ADA & Fair Housing ground floor units will need to be adaptable and allow for people with disability to adapt for those with those needs
- o Will this affect existing buildings being renovated?
 - No this already exist in the IEBC (International Existing Building Code)
