SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
\$1,900,000 shall be made available to the Department of Public Works – Service 663 (Waste
Removal and Recycling) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal
Year 2023, to provide funding for balancing the Department of Public Works budget for Fiscal
Year 2023 due to landfill tipping fees and vehicle rental fees exceeding the adopted budget. The
source of revenue for this appropriation is generated from investment earnings in excess of the
amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy
required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2023.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
