SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

SUBTITLE 18A. LANDMARK LIST: EXTERIORS – 2020S

§ 18A-2. TRUCK HOUSE NO. 5. (OLIVER COMMUNITY FIREHOUSE)

TRUCK HOUSE NO. 5 (OLIVER COMMUNITY FIREHOUSE), 1220 EAST OLIVER STREET.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
