11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
12 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

14 **Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation**

15 **Subtitle 13A. Landmark List: Public Interiors - 2010s**

16 **§ 13A-3. ST. JOHN’S IN THE VILLAGE.**

17 ST. JOHN’S IN THE VILLAGE, 3009½ GREENMOUNT AVENUE.

18 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
19 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
20 Ordinance.

21 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
22 after the date it is enacted.
