INTRODUCTION – RPP Area 2 (Morgan) - Plan Amendment

PURPOSE/PLANS – For the purpose of adding the 1500 and 1600 blocks of Argonne Drive, odd side, to the Parking Management Plan for RPP Area 2; and correcting related language.

COMMENTS – This bill looks to amend the boundaries of Baltimore City Parking Authority’s existing Area 2 Residential Permit Parking (RPP) Program. The amended boundaries will incorporate the odd sides of the 1500 and 1600 blocks of Argonne Drive into the existing Area 2 RPP Program. This is being sought in conjunction of the active redevelopment of the old Northwood Shopping Center into Northwood Commons.

Generally, the Baltimore City Department of Transportation defers to the Baltimore City Parking Authority on legislation that amends existing RPP areas. It is worth noting that the Department of Transportation is actively negotiating the final Developer’s Agreement with the development team.
