City Streets – Opening – Hunter Street

For the purpose of condemning and opening Hunter Street, extending from the north side of a 10-foot alley, laid out in the rear of the properties known as 210 through 218/220-222 East Preston Street, Northerly 94.1 feet, more or less, to the south side of a 7-foot alley, laid out in the rear of the properties known as 209 through 217 East Mount Royal Avenue, as shown on Plat 338-A-21 in the Office of the Department of Public Works; and providing for a special effective date.

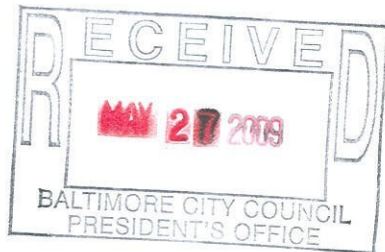
The Department of Transportation has no objections to the passage of this bill.
