AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

1 General Fund Operating Appropriation Transfer –
2 Health Department (Program 310) to
3 Mayoralty Educational Grants (Program 446) – \$200,000

4 FOR the purpose of transferring a General Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of
5 \$200,000 from the Health Department (Program 310) to Mayoralty Educational Grants
6 (Program 446); and providing for a special effective date.

12 Recitals

13 Article VI, § 9(a)(2) of the City Charter provides that, on recommendation of the Board of
14 Estimates, the City Council by ordinance may authorize the transfer of an appropriation
15 contained in the Ordinance of Estimates from one municipal agency to another municipal
16 agency.

17 The sum of \$200,000, as appropriated to the Health Department (Program 310) in the Fiscal
18 2011 Ordinance of Estimates, is not needed for the purpose for which it was appropriated and,
19 therefore, is available for transfer to another agency.

20 On July 14, 2010, the Board of Estimates recommended the transfer authorized by this
21 Ordinance.

22 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
23 sum of \$200,000, contained in the Fiscal 2011 Ordinance of Estimates as a General Fund
24 Operating Appropriation, is transferred from the Health Department (Program 310) to Mayoralty
25 Educational Grants (Program 446).
